Deliverable Description

This Deliverable is a report on the acknowledged publications and presentations made by members of the COMPARE Consortium during the project period.

COMPARE participants will actively seek to publish the results of COMPARE in peer-reviewed scientific journals, acknowledging COMPARE and the European Commission (in compliance with article 29.4 of the H2020 Grant Agreement). All principal investigators strived to publish their results in open-access journals (Gold model). In case publication in open-access journals is not feasible, the publications will be made available via the COMPARE website, respecting any embargo periods of the journal (Green model).

The lead investigators in COMPARE are all well-embedded in national and international networks, advisory committees, professional societies and conferences. As such, they functioned as ambassadors of COMPARE within these large networks. COMPARE consortium members have presented the progress of activities at national and international conferences.

Publications

COMPARE participants have published results from the project in peer-reviewed scientific journals, acknowledging the support from Horizon 2020 and naming the Grant No 643476.

Over the course of the project, COMPARE participants have published more than 240 articles. In addition, there are approximately 30+ articles being written, under submission, in review, or in press at the end of the COMPARE project. It is certain that COMPARE will be acknowledged in even more articles in the years following the end of the project. The participants published their results in open-access journals (Gold model or Green model).

The COMPARE/Horizon 2020 acknowledged articles have been recorded in the EC participant Portal as well as being listed on the COMPARE public website <u>https://www.compare-europe.eu/library/scientific-publications.</u>

COMPARE participants have been published in a wide range of journals, from Nature Microbiology to European Journal of Health Economics, from Microbial Genomics to Emerging Infectious Diseases, from Science to Virus Research, and from Nature Communications to Risk Analysis.
